

## Joann Lytle recognized as one of Business Insurance's 2014 "Women to Watch"

PHILADELPHIA—Prominent insurance publication *Business Insurance* has named Joann Lytle, an insurance coverage Partner in McCarter & English's Philadelphia office, one of its Women to Watch for 2014. The annual feature, aimed at highlighting the most influential and inspiring women in the field and encouraging the achievements and further success of women in this largely male-dominated industry, recognizes 25 women leaders doing outstanding insurance-related work in risk and benefits management, commercial insurance, consulting, the law, and other fields.

Lytle represents corporate policyholders in insurance coverage disputes and has recovered hundreds of millions of dollars in insurance assets for a wide range of companies in the manufacturing, food services, health care, banking and natural resources industries—among many others. A panel of the magazine's senior editors selected the final 25 women based on the winners' recent professional achievements, influence on the insurance and business marketplace, and contributions to the advancement of women in business. Recognition on the list is especially impressive given that it includes women from across all insurance-related fields, not only insurance law, and is open to women leaders worldwide who are connected to the commercial insurance industry.
