PHILADELPHIA – A prestigious publication that covers law and the legal profession in Philadelphia has named Philip Amoa, a corporate lawyer with McCarter & English, to its 2014 list of "Lawyers on the Fast Track."

*The Legal Intelligencer* will publish its list of up-and-coming stars, with full profiles of the honorees, in its Sept. 30th issue, recognizing young lawyers in Philadelphia and throughout Pennsylvania "who exemplify the very best of what the profession has to offer." This year, 36 lawyers were named to the list, which aims to highlight "the next generation of Pennsylvania attorneys" under the age of 40 who are "already making an impact on the legal community and will [continue to] grow in stature as they advance in their careers."

The newspaper solicited nominations from law firms throughout the state, public interest groups, bar associations, and *The Legal Intelligencer's* readership.
