She managed a portfolio that included the \$7.5 billion Systems Engineering, Technology, and Innovation (SETI) contract, the \$997 million Mission Partner Environment Services contract, and the \$350 million Agency Program Support contract. She was also responsible for all legal aspects of multimillion-dollar information technology and service support contracts, including advising on matters from requirement development to contract administration, managing discovery, and litigating issues regarding responses to contracting officer final decisions (COFDs), contractor performance assessment reporting system (CPARS) ratings, requests for equitable adjustments, and contract terminations for default and convenience. Prior to her position at DISA's Office of General Counsel, Andriani served as a contracting officer with DISA and as a contract specialist with the National Institute of Health giving her a unique perspective and insight into the intricacies of government contracts.
